The Teatro Olimpico (Olympic Theatre) in Vicenza is the oldest surviving Renaissance theatre in the world. The Teatro Olimpico is one of Vicenza's artistic wonders and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Andrea Palladio, who was openly inspired by the Roman theatres described by Vitruvius. Andrea Palladio began this masterwork on behalf of the Accademia Olimpica in early 1580. Following the unexpected death of the architect on 19 August 1580, the theatre was completed by Vincenzo Scamozzi. In the history of theatre buildings, the Teatro Olimpico in Vicenza by Andrea Palladio is often regarded as the archetype of the evolution of spaces for drama and performance.
